LINK Parliamentary Monitoring Service now available to LINK Subscribers

The Scottish Parliamentary monitoring service is produced by LINK staff for LINK's member organisations. It is available (from July 2008) for an additional fee to LINK Subscribers which are not eligible for membership of LINK. The content aims to be relevant to LINK members' interests, covering issues of core relevance to Scotland's environmental sustainability. The service primarily alerts recipients to the environmentally relevant business coming up over the next week in the Scottish Parliament, and reviews recent action.

Terms and conditions

- 1. The service is available by email.
- 2. The service is normally provided weekly. The average provision over the year is 45 weeks out of 52. The interruptions are mainly due to staff holidays and where possible will occur during parliamentary recess.
- 3. The fee for the service (currently £200 per year) is payable annually in advance at the end of a free trial period of one month. The fee is in addition to the normal Subscriber subscription (currently £50 per year).
- 4. The service is provided to a named individual a LINK Subscriber. Passing the email on to third parties is not normally permitted, without express written permission from the provider.
- 5. If the service is interrupted for a continuous period longer than one month, the next invoice to the recipient will be delayed by an equivalent time period.
- 6. If the service should be discontinued at any time by LINK, a proportion of the annual fee will be refunded to the recipient.
- 7. LINK reserves the right to withdraw the service at any time, if there is reason to believe the conditions of use are being misused.
