Grant will be used to fund information panels, launch event costs, speakers fees, publicity for exhibition and writers competition.

Grant will allow the group to deliver a programme of indoor and outdoor activities for local young people, to stimulate an interest and understanding of nature conservation and the environment. Grant will also be used to provide first aid training for group leaders.
